

Hands-On...

Moses & Mt. Sinai

You'll Need:

1. Foam board
2. Clip-art of Moses, Mt. Sinai and the Ten Commandments.
3. Glue-stick
4. Razor-blade
5. Magnet
6. 2 paper-clips
7. Clear packaging tape or contact paper.

Print two 4-5" pictures of Moses; I chose to use one image of Moses with his staff and the other with the Ten Commandments. Cut them out and laminate them, or glue them to the foam board and cut them out with a razor blade.

If you've laminated the images, then affix a paper clip to the back with tape. If you've cut them out of foam board, then insert the paper clip into the foam. Put the clip at the top (otherwise, Moses gets dragged up Mt. Sinai by his feet... LOL!).

Enlarge the image of Mt. Sinai so that you have to print parts of the picture on separate pages and then glue them to the foam board and seal the poster with clear packaging tape or contact paper.

Using a strong magnet on the back of the board will make it appear as if Moses is climbing Mt. Sinai!
