[G-D-G]Chameish, cha-meish is five. (Can you [C]count to [D]six?)

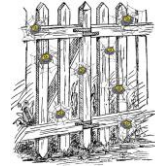


[G-Em-Am-D]Sheish, sheish, sheish is six,
